New Business Items:

- 1. Any thoughts on why our participation down? How do we resolve the matter? This was occurring in June. *Conclusion:* Seems to be a common occurrence every year during the beginning of the summer months. League loses players summering in other places.
- 2. Dues will be \$75.00 versus \$70.00 per AGA. They will not be giving the \$5.00 discount starting October 1, 2025. Do we want to raise the dues to \$80.00? George to address. Motion by George Kowalchik to raise dues starting January 1, 2026 from \$70.00 / \$75.00 (after October 1, 2025) to \$80.00. Seconded by Bob Froehlich. All members voted in favor or raising dues. Reasons: Add reserves for future computers and raise money for additional tournaments paid for by the league. Also, club will receiving \$35.00 per player versus \$30.00 from the AGA as part of annual dues.
- 3. Bob Froehlich requested to discuss 2026 TPO dates as a matter of scheduling Wednesday events next year.
- 4. Tiebreaker procedure for multi-course tournaments TPO, Trifecta & CC. How does the board want to input how tiebreakers get determined into GG? Golf Genius utilizes standard protocols in breaking ties based on the final round's back-9 holes. That player with the lowest back 9-hole score wins. If there is still a tie, then Golf Genius calculates the last 6 holes, the last 3 holes and finally, the last hole. If a ties still exists, then a coin is flipped to determine the winner.
- 5. VGA aging. Are there any thoughts regarding recruiting younger members. *Board agrees that membership is aging but membership remains stable.*
- 6. Brian Dempster made an interesting point regarding our treasury pay-out for the TPO to members who rarely play. Any thoughts on revising our rules or requirements to play in the event or paying less and distributing remaining funds for other events? *Board agrees with Brian that prize money may need to be redistributed. This issue is shelved to the next meeting.*

- 7. How do we want to handle cash distributions for par 3's that were not hit in regulation? Issue resolved. Doug Walsh to discuss. Doug Walsh presented the following motion: Pay par-3 the amount earned. In other words, if a par-3 is not won by any players, then the monies generated for par 3 will be distributed equally to those hit in regulation. If for example only 3 of 4 par 3 are won, then total par-3 prize money will be allocated to 3 of the 4 par 3s. Seconded by George Kowalchik. All members voted in favor of this motion.
- 8. Will the board approve narrative regarding the following: We encourage our members to input scores from courses played outside VGA events into the GHIN system on a hole-by-hole basis? Reason: Handicaps can be slightly different if inputs are on a whole-number basis. Board recommends to the membership that it input all scores outside VGA events to the GHIN app on a hole-by-hole basis. Reason: This is a more accurate of account of a players handicap versus inputting a total score.
